



THIRD-PARTY GOVERNMENT ENTITY TESTING ANOTHER GOVERNMENT ENTITY

APPLICATION AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

NAC 483.1224

Governmental entities that are part of the Nevada Commercial Driver License (CDL) Third-Party Program may allow their designated Third-Party Certifiers to certify the driving ability of employees of other Nevada Government entities within limitations set forth by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).

LIMITATIONS SET FORTH BY THE DEPARTMENT

1. This Application and Acknowledgement form must be submitted to the CDL Third-Party Coordinator for review and approval prior to scheduling tests with individuals outside the Third-Party Certifier's department.
2. Test Applicant must complete Entry Level Driver Training (ELDT) requirements, if applicable, with a training provider listed on the Federal Motor Carrier's Administration's (FMCSA) Training Provider Registry (TPR). Training Providers must meet all required state regulations.
3. Test Applicant must be an employee of a Nevada Governmental Entity and provide the following items to the Third-Party Certifier/Company prior to testing; with the understanding that this information will be maintained by the Third-Party Company:
 - a. Copy of base license and Commercial Learner Permit; and
 - b. DMV Record Printout; and
 - c. Medical Examiners Certificate if self-certified as "Non-Exempt"; and
 - d. Proof of employment; and
 - e. Proof of CDL skills training with trainers' information and hours completed; and
 - f. Copy of Score sheet(s) will be kept.
4. Test applicant must conduct the CDL skills test with the vehicles provided by the Third-Party Company, of which, both Departments acknowledge and accept liability issues for the driver.
5. The test applicant and their department are aware that testing through a Third-Party Certifier is subject to auditing procedures by the department as described in **NAC 483**. Failure to comply with auditing requirements will subject the driver to cancellation of their driving privileges.
