THE EMISSIONS INSPECTION FOR DIESEL VEHICLES INCLUDE: LIGHT DUTY VEHICLES 1968 AND NEWER WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING OF 14,000 POUNDS OR LESS:

- (1) DYNAMOMETER TEST UNDER LOAD
- (2) VISUAL INSPECTION OF SPECIFIC EMISSION DEVICES BASED UPON MODEL YEAR
- (3) STANDARDS FOR OPACITY 40% 4,000 FT OR MORE, 30% UNDER 4000 FT ELEVATION

OPACITY DEFINED – NAC 445B.442 - OPACITY MEANS THE PROPERTY OF A SUBSTANCE TENDING TO OBSCURE VISION AND MEASURED IN TERMS OF PERCENT OBSCURATION.
