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SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT INFORMATION SHEET

NRS 366.085, 482.123, 484.173, 706.121

Pursuant to the above statutes, a motor vehicle designated as Special Mobile Equipment must only be incidentally operated or moved upon a highway when travel is required to complete a task for which the equipment is assigned. Special Mobile Equipment may not be used for the primary purpose of the transportation of persons or property.

Examples of Special Mobile Equipment and Towable Tools:

Single-axle dollies, scoop mobiles, forklifts, ditch-digging apparatus, and road construction and maintenance machinery such as asphalt graders, bituminous mixers, bucket loaders, tractors other than truck tractors, leveling graders, finishing machines, motor graders, road rollers, scarifiers, earth-moving carryalls and scrapers, power shovels and draglines, and earth-moving equipment. The term also includes towable tools or equipment such as air compressors, concrete mixers, arc welders, tarpots, engine hoists, plaster mixers, mortar mixers, grout pumps, portable conveyors, generators, log splitters, brush chippers, spray rigs, tree spades, scissor lifts, light towers, pumps, steam cleaners, sand blasters, welders, stump grinders, radial arm saws, sod cutters, aerators, pavement rollers, and scaffolding.

Examples of Vehicles which do not qualify as Special Mobile Equipment:

Concrete pumpers, cranes, or well (boring) drilling equipment with highway rated tires which are operated over the public highway, trailers, house trailers, dump trucks, truck mounted transit mixers, any vehicle originally designed and manufactured to transport persons or property and to which machinery has been attached, water trucks used on any portion of the public highway other than a controlled–access highway (as defined in NRS 484.041), or a vehicle to which machinery for sweeping is mounted or attached.

Note: Special Mobile Equipment is exempt from registration and fuel taxes.

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
