



## OLD TIMER LICENSE PLATE APPLICATION

### NRS 482.381

A Nevada resident who owns a vehicle manufactured more than 40 years prior to the date of application may apply for Old Timer license plates. Old Timer license plates are inscribed with the words "OLD TIMER" and four (4) sequential numbers. Personalization of these plates is not allowed. An Old Timer license plate may be issued for any non-commercial use motor vehicle, including a motorcycle.

The initial fee for an Old Timer license plate is \$35.00. For those motor vehicles exempt from emission testing, the Department will collect a one-time fee of \$6.00, to be deposited into the pollution control account. These fees are in addition to all other registration fees. The renewal fee for an Old Timer license plate is \$10, in addition to all other applicable registration fees.

If your vehicle is currently registered, you have the option to maintain your current vehicle expiration date or renewing for a full twelve (12) month period. Credit for the unused portion of your current registration will be applied. You must surrender your current license plates to the Department to transfer this credit.

**Vehicle owners with Classic Vehicle, Classic Rod, or Old Timer plates must provide proof that the vehicle is covered by Nevada liability insurance that is specifically designated for classic or antique vehicles. Customer must provide the declaration page from the insurer for first time registration and/or renewal. Liability insurance must be continuously maintained in the registered owner's name for the entire time the vehicle is registered. As required by NRS 484D.315, the vehicle's odometer must be operational.**

In accordance with **NAC 445B.574**, the provisions of NAC 445B.574 to 445B.603, inclusive, do not apply to a motor vehicle for which special license plates have been issued pursuant to NRS 482.381 (Antique vehicle "Old Timer") if the owner of the motor vehicle certifies, pursuant to NRS 445B.760, that the vehicle was not driven more than 5,000 miles during the year immediately preceding the date of the certification. Each annual registration renewal must recertify that the vehicle was not driven more than 5,000 miles since the preceding annual registration. If the vehicle is driven over 5,000 miles, the Old Timer plate registration will not be renewed. Attach Department form EC-18, Odometer Certification for Emission Exemption to this application.

**Please Note:** First time application for this plate type must be done in person at a full-service DMV office. Registration renewal can be conducted on the [MyDMV](http://MyDMV) portal, faxed to (775) 684-4797, or mailed to the DMV office above.
