



CLASSIC ROD LICENSE PLATE APPLICATION

NRS 482.3814 & NAC 445B.574

A Nevada resident who owns a passenger car or light duty, non-commercial vehicle (having a manufacturer's rated carrying capacity of 1 ton or less), manufactured not earlier than 1949, but at least 20 years prior to the date of application, may apply for Classic Rod license plates. Classic Rod license plates are inscribed with the words CLASSIC ROD and four numbers. The initial fee for a Classic Rod license plate is \$35.00, plus 50 cents per plate Prison Industry Fee. For those motor vehicles exempted from emission testing, the Department will collect a one-time fee of \$6.00 to be deposited into the pollution control account; these fees are in addition to all other registration fees. The renewal fee for a Classic Rod license plate is \$10.00 in addition to all other applicable registration fees.

If your vehicle is currently registered, you have the option to maintain your current vehicle expiration date or renewing for a full twelve (12) month period. Credit for the unused portion of your current registration will be applied. You must surrender your current license plates to the Department to transfer this credit.

Vehicle owners with Classic Rod plates must provide proof that the vehicle is covered by Nevada liability insurance which is specifically designated for classic or antique vehicles. Customer must provide the declaration page from the insurer for first time registration and/or renewal. Liability insurance must be continuously maintained in the registered owner's name, for the entire time the vehicle is registered in Nevada. As required by NRS 484D.315, the vehicle's odometer must be operational.

In accordance with [NAC 445B.574](#), the provisions of NAC 445B.574 to 445B.603, inclusive, do not apply to a motor vehicle for which special license plates have been issued pursuant to NRS 482.3814 (Classic Rods) if the owner of the motor vehicle certifies, pursuant to NRS 445B.760, that the vehicle was not driven more than 5,000 miles during the year immediately preceding the date of the certification. Each annual registration renewal must recertify that the vehicle was not driven more than 5,000 miles since the preceding annual registration. Attach Department form [EC-18, Odometer Certification for Emission Exemption at initial registration and annual renewal](#). If the vehicle is driven more than 5,000 miles, a passing emissions test is required at the time of the renewal and the vehicle cannot be re-registered as a Classic Rod vehicle.

Please Note: First time application for this plate type must be done in person at a full-service DMV office. Registration renewal can be conducted on the [MyDMV](#) portal, faxed to (775) 684-4797, or mailed to the DMV office above.
