

BRONZE/SILVER STAR LICENSE PLATE APPLICATION NRS 482.3783

A Nevada resident who is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States and awarded the Bronze or Silver Star is entitled to two sets of specially designed license plates which indicate that he/she is a recipient of either of these awards. A person who qualifies may register up to two passenger cars, motorcycles, trailers, or light commercial vehicles having a manufacturer rated carrying capacity of 1 ton or less, for his/her own personal use.

Application must be made in person at a full-service DMV office. The Bronze or Silver Star License Plate may be personalized. Nevada evidence of insurance must be presented when you visit the DMV.

Any applicable registration, transfer, and Governmental Services Tax will be charged for issuance or renewal of either of these license plates. A license **plate production fee of \$3.75 per plate**, a prison industry fee of 50 cents per plate, in addition to all other applicable fees.

One of the following documents must be attached to this application:

- a. General Order awarding the Bronze Star with "V" Device, Combat V, or Combat Distinguishing Device or Silver Star from a service headquarters signed or stamped Official Copy.
- b. Other acceptable official documentation as determined by the Department.
- If applying for Bronze or Silver Star disabled plate, must present documentation from the Veteran's Administration to verify 100% service-connected disability.

The vehicle bearing Bronze or Silver Star Disabled license plates is exempt from the payment of parking fees, including those collected through parking meters, charged by the State of Nevada, or any political subdivision or other public body within the State. Disabled license plates do not authorize the parking of a motor vehicle in any privately or municipally owned facility.

An owner or operator of a motor vehicle displaying special disabled plates issued pursuant to **NRS 482.377** may park in a parking space designated for the handicapped (**NRS 484B.463, 484B.467**).

PLEASE NOTE: These parking privileges are unique to Nevada and may not be applicable or honored in other states.

If your vehicle is currently registered, you have the option of maintaining your current vehicle registration expiration date or renewing for a full 12-month period. Credit for any unused portion of your current registration will be applied to your renewal. In applicable counties, if you are renewing for a full 12-month period, and your previous evidence of compliance with emissions standards was obtained more than 90 days ago, the vehicle must be re-inspected prior to registration.

(NRS 482.3667 and NAC 482.320). All personalized plates are subject to an approval process; you will be notified if the plates you have requested are denied. The DMV may prohibit the transfer of personalized license plates from one vehicle to another if such transfer would result in an inappropriate use of letters or combination of letters and numbers.
