Approval of Agenda

The agenda was approved by the committee in the order it was presented.

Approval of August 13th, 2021, Meeting Minutes

Meeting Minutes approved unanimously.

Review of BDR 43-348-Authorizing the Appointment of an Agent of the DMV to Issue Salvage Titles

- Dick Mills (Wreckers); Questions if any new information available
- Michelle McClellan (Salvage Pool); This is not in effect yet. Mr. Hefner was reached out to, there has been no response yet.
- Blake Pride-Zorn (Dealer); Questions what the process is since DMV already processes titles.
- Michelle McClellan (Salvage Pool); Agrees that DMV does create salvage titles, but like AAA, Salvage Pools are looking to act as agents and be able to print the salvage titles. The DMV is very behind and hopefully this helps the backlog. It would make the process quicker; industries would be paid a lot quicker.
- Dick Mills (Wreckers); This was passed in the last legislative session. It now needs to be implemented by the DMV.

Review Secure POAs and E Signature

- Michelle McClellan (Salvage Pools); Looking for an update in the secure POAs and E signature process. E signatures are a lot more accommodating for customers. E signatures were allowed for a long time until it was taken away a few years ago.
- Blake Pride-Zorn (Dealer); Agrees that it is much more accommodating for customers. States that he does a lot of out of state deals, and it creates a lot of delays to get wet signatures. Questions why it was taken away.

- Michelle McClellan (Salvage Pools); Believes someone re-read the law and felt it was incorrect. A lot of states are changing to E POAs. Our DMV felt that since it did not have an odometer disclosure on it that it was not correct. If an odometer disclosure was added to the electronic POA it would suffice. Believes that an electronic POA is more secure than a secure POA.
- Dick Mills (Wreckers); Questions if that is something that the DMV can change, or does it require an NRS statute.
- Michelle McClellan (Salvage Pools); Does not believe it requires an NRS statute, but rather that the DMV can change it.
- Blake Pride-Zorn (Dealers); States this would be a good recommendation to switch back to E signatures.
- Michelle McClellan (Salvage Pools); Agrees with this.

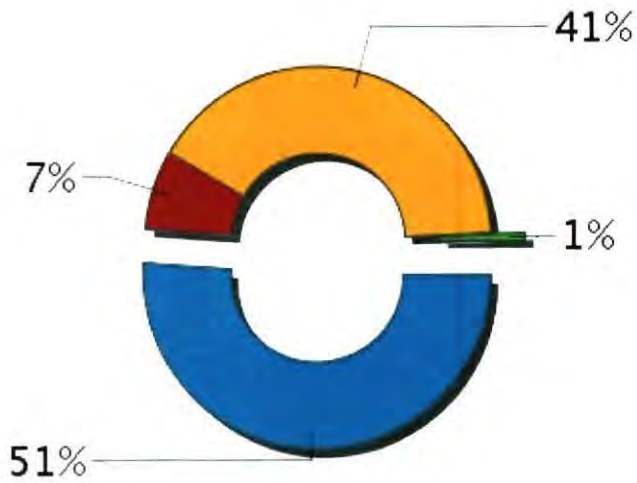

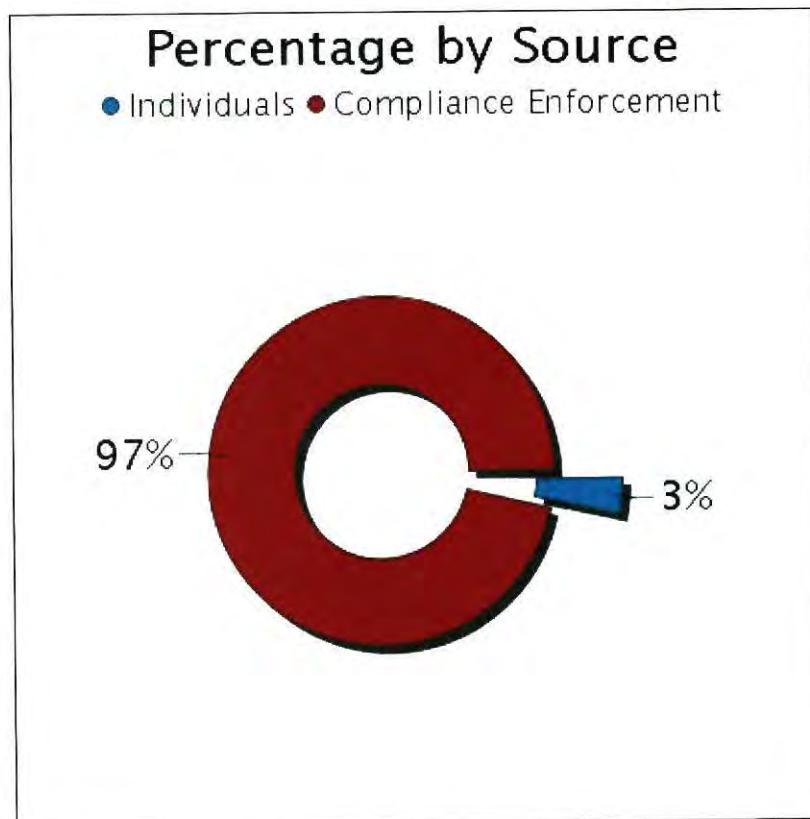

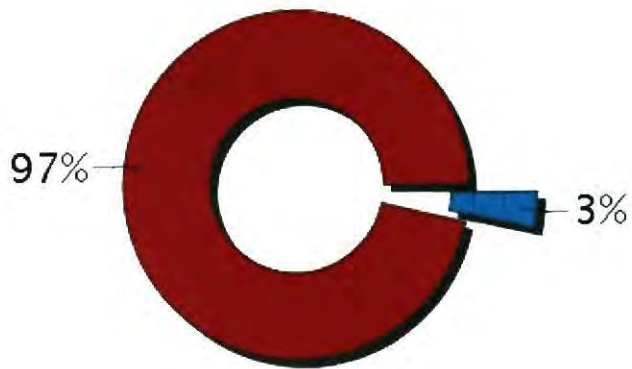

● Complaint ● Emission Station Covert



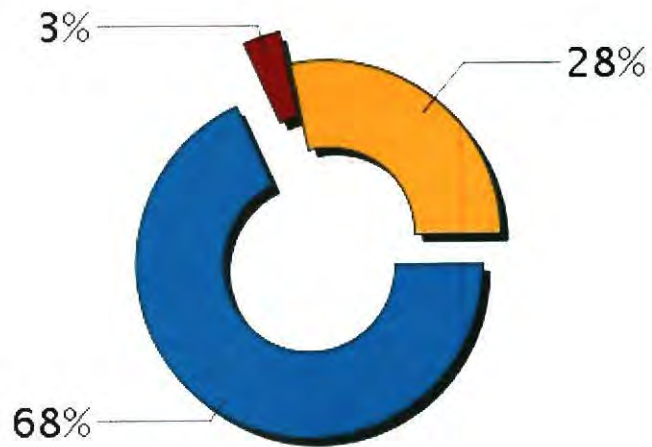

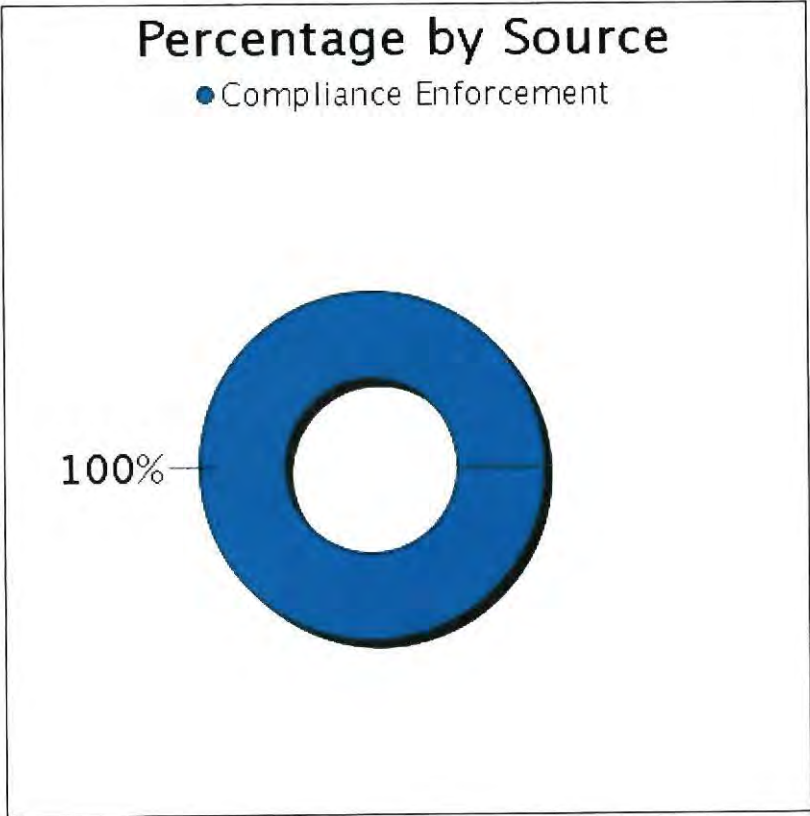
