• **Nevada LIVE Status Updates:**

- Legislative Updates: AB504 (Bill for sole source provider – InsureNet) did not pass. It did not come out of the Assembly. SB312 (bill for Nevada LIVE project) was signed by the Governor on June 1<sup>st</sup>. We will continue to move on the same path with the Nevada LIVE Project.
- Insurance Company User Requirements: We are hoping to have the user requirements posted on the web in draft form within the next two weeks. Please review the draft and notify Bernadette Nieto @ [bnieto.dmv.nv.gov](mailto:bnieto.dmv.nv.gov) if you have any suggestions.

• **Motor Vehicle Information Technology (MVIT) Updates:**

- Mani and Sondra will be busy with other projects for a few months, but other staff will be working full time on the Nevada LIVE project.
- Mani has been meeting with our Information Technology Department and IBM to arrange for a Secure FTP directly to our mainframe for companies that do not currently have web services. MVIT is working with IBM on problems we are having in accessing some of the company's web services directly from the mainframe.
- MVIT continues to develop internal web pages. For the small insurance companies (less than 500 vehicles) and self-insured that will not have web services, MVIT is developing web pages so the companies can upload their information from an Excel spreadsheet.

**Questions and Answer Period:**

Is the web site temporary until online verification comes on board or are you thinking about going directly to FTP instead?

- Sondra Baker stated: We will have a parallel process for awhile so companies currently sending tape cartridge's, CD's, diskettes, or email attachments will still have a facility to send to while the companies are changing their process. Our goal is to eventually have all companies on web services.

Foremost currently sends a disc. At this time should we be working towards online verification? Is there anything else we can be upgrading or using?

- Sondra Baker: Yes. At this time we are trying to make FTP available.

Is the server going to go through Vericon or is Nevada doing it themselves?

- The server will be done by Nevada. We are not using third party vendors.

Shawn Higgins – GEICO: When will secure FTP be available?

- Unknown at this time.

Sandy Clark – ACE American: Are you going to do personal and commercial policies?

- Yes, we will be doing both.

If the initial Book of Business upload cannot be sent to secure FTP, do you want it on cartridge?

- Sondra Baker: For the one time process we can do this through our secure server.

Once you receive the Book of Business when can we stop sending the tapes?

- Sondra Baker: Once testing of web services are successfully and we have uploaded the Book of Business it will be quite rapid when we start using the web services. Tapes will no longer need to be sent.

Are fleet vehicles exempt from reporting?

- No. Only vehicles 26,001 lbs and over will be temporarily exempt from our verification program.

Will VINS's have to be reported or report on a policy level?

- If it is non-vehicle specific and we would match by the FEIN.
